
LARCHMONT VILLAGE POWER POLE REPLACEMENT PROJECT INTERMITTENT PARTIAL ALLEY CLOSURE



LADWP will be replacing power poles in your neighborhood beginning on May 16, 2016 as part of a critical infrastructure improvement project necessary to ensure continued power reliability for customers in the Larchmont Village area. The pole replacement will take place in the alley between Larchmont Blvd. and Lucerne Blvd, from Beverly Blvd. to First Street.

Schedule

Pole replacement will begin May 16, 2016 and continue through approximately November 2016.

Work hours will be from Monday through Saturday, from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., and may include some Sundays. Crews may work extended hours Tuesday through Thursday until 6 p.m. to expedite work.

What to Expect

- The alley will be occasionally closed to through traffic in order to conduct work safely; however, access to the alley and businesses will be maintained.
- For safety reasons, power service to customers may be interrupted temporarily during the project. Customers will be given a two-day advance notification if any planned outage will last more than 2 hours.
