We have been working closely with the Councilman's office to move the Farmers Market to a location that works for the Farmers Market as well as the community. We do not intend to leave the Larchmont area. We have been an important part of the community for 18 years and we have no intention of changing that.

The reality is that the market has grown over the 18 years and while we have loved our current location, we also would like the opportunity to find a new home where we have a bit more room to accommodate the demand of the community. Many of our farmers and vendors have been with the market for the full 18 years and the majority have been there at least 10 years. We have seen the community grow and blossom over the almost 2 decades and we are a part of the fabric of the community and there is no intention of us leaving.

We have been assured by the Councilman's representatives that they will find us a home that allows all current vendors to stay in the market and we do not need to downsize the market, even during construction. In the event that we have not been able to move the market into a suitable location by the time construction starts, we have an alternate plan in place so that no vendors are lost or downsized. The Farmers Market has always been of the position that the Market either finds a new location that we can expand to or we stay in our current location with a plan to make sure that we are not downsized. The Councilman's Office has always been in full support of this position in our conversations.

We greatly appreciate your support, but please do not worry; we will not be leaving the Larchmont Blvd. area.
